

EMS is Dispatched 33 Times Each Month for Drug-Related Incidents in Skagit County. Narcan Saves a Life Every 4.5 Days





DIAGNOSIS OF NB DRUG WITHDRAWAL


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DIAGNOSIS OF DRUG USE DURING PREGNANCY OF POISONING




WA State DBHR Substance Abuse Treatment Analyzer Count of Skagit County Residents CD Treatment Admissions (All modalities)






Before you began using heroin were you hooked on prescription-type opiates?






Interest in getting help to reduce or quit drug use among those not in drug treatment


