The City Council study session was called to order by Mayor Johnson at 6:00 P.M.

Motion to approve the agenda made by Councilmember Kesti and seconded by Councilmember Allen. Motion carried 7-0.

Mayor & Council Reports

Mayor Johnson spoke about COVID cases being the highest they have been since the start of the pandemic, the increases in hospitalizations as well as the fact that 72.5% of Skagit County are now at least partially vaccinated. Councilmembers spoke about issues with the contractors working in town and not properly restoring the yards and driveways to the original condition, a possible "Clean Up Day" after the recent storms, the possible need for parking lines down at the boat ramp located at Riverfront Park, franchise agreements with Comcast and Puget Sound Energy as well as upcoming contract negotiations with AFSCME in the next couple of weeks.

Executive Session

At 6:21 P.M. Mayor Johnson moved the Councilmembers into Executive Session, per RCW42.30.110 and included the City Attorney as well as the Police Chief for the Executive Session tonight.

At 6:40 P.M. Mayor Johnson resumed the regular session.

Motion made to authorize city the City Attorney to file pleadings necessary to seek a warrant of abatement for property located at 206 Puget St., Sedro-Woolley by Councilmember Kesti and seconded by Councilmember Allen. Motion carried (7-0).
