- 5. Ordinance 2029-22 Historic Preservation 1st Read. After information was presented by City Administrator, Charlie Bush, and a lengthy discussion, a motion was made by Councilmember Kesti and seconded by Councilmember Burns to adopt Ordinance 2029-22. Motion carried (7-0).
