NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEARBY GIVEN that the City of Sedro-Woolley City Council will hold a public hearing at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, May 8th 2019 at City Hall, 325 Metcalf.

The purpose of the public hearing is to review community development and housing needs, inform citizens of the availability of funds and eligible uses of the state Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and receive comments on proposed activities, particularly from persons with lower income. Up to \$750,000 may be available to the City of Sedro-Woolley on a statewide competitive basis to fund public facility, community facility, economic development, planning and affordable housing projects that principally benefit persons with low- and moderate-income. An outline of the proposed Home Trust of Skagit project is available for review at City Hall, 325 Metcalf Street, during normal business hours. Comments may also be submitted in writing to the City Supervisor by May 23rd. Citizens are encouraged to attend this hearing or submit comments in writing to Eron Berg, City Supervisor, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, WA 98284.

If special accommodations are needed to participate in the hearing, please contact the City at least three days prior to the hearing date.
